

**MIAMI OPEN COIN TOSS ENTER TO WIN SWEEPSTAKES  
FULL OFFICIAL RULES**

**PROMOTION OPEN ONLY TO LEGAL RESIDENTS OF FLORIDA 18 YEARS AND OLDER  
AT TIME OF ENTRY**

**1. No Purchase Necessary:** NO ENTRY FEE, PAYMENT, OR PROOF OF PURCHASE IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. The Promotion is void outside of the State of Florida. Must be 18 years or older at time of entry to enter.

**2. To Enter:** The promotion described herein, including the prize drawing, shall be hereinafter referred to as the “Promotion.” To enter, during the Promotion Period set forth below, entrants may enter their contact information on a publicly accessible landing page, located at <https://www.miamiopen.com/miami-invitational-etw/>, which will also be accessible via a QR code located at or around the Miami Invitational hosted at IoanDepot Park (the “Park”), located at 501 Marlins Way, Miami, Florida 33125. The Promotion begins on December 8, 2025, at 4:00 p.m. ET and ends on or about December 8, 2025, at 11:59 p.m. ET (the “Promotion Period”). On-site entry for the Miami Invitational is available at the Park for the duration of the Promotion Period.

**3. Prize/Drawing:** The Promotion will consist of one (1) random drawing for one (1) prize pack, which consists of one (1) grandstand coin toss at the 2026 Miami Open, where the winner will have the opportunity to be on the tennis court and flip the coin at the start of a tennis match on the Grandstand court (collectively, the “Prize”) and two (2) stadium tickets to the 2026 Miami Open. Sponsor shall have sole discretion over the exact tennis match, date, and any other details concerning the coin toss.

- **Approximate retail value (ARV) of each Prize:**
  - **One (1) Miami Grandstand Coin Toss Experience - \$1,000.00**
  - **Two (2) Stadium Tickets to the 2026 Miami Open - \$300.00**
- **Approximate retail value (ARV) of the Prize: \$1,300.00**

All additional expenses that are not specifically included in the Prize as stated above, including, but not limited to, shipping or delivery of the Prize, insurance, and federal, state, and local taxes, title, and registration expenses, are the winner’s sole responsibility and may need to be prepaid, in part or in whole, prior to receipt of the Prize. Winner's guest must be of legal age of majority in his/her(their) jurisdiction(s) of residence unless accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. The terms and conditions of the tickets awarded as part of the prize will govern in the event a match is not played or held due to weather conditions, an act of God, an act of terrorism, civil disturbance, or any other reason. Sponsor and Hard Rock Stadium reserve the right to remove or to deny entry to winner and/or his/her guest(s) who engage in a non-sportsmanlike or disruptive manner or with intent to annoy, abuse, threaten, or harass any other person at the game. In the event that the tennis match does not take place as scheduled, for reasons such as cancellation, preemption or postponement, or for any reason beyond the control of the Sponsor, no additional substitution or compensation will be provided. The tickets may not be resold, offered for resale, or used for any commercial or promotional purpose whatsoever. Any such resale or commercial or promotional use may result in disqualification and prize forfeiture and may invalidate the license granted by the tickets.

**5. Waiver/Release:** By entering, entrants agree to be bound by these Official Rules and the decisions of Sponsor and irrevocably consent to Sponsor's use of their names, biographical information, image, and likeness without limitation, in any media now in existence or hereafter devised, for advertising, publicity or other commercial purposes without further consideration, except where prohibited by law.
